Requirements for auditions:

- 1) All grades- 16 bars or 1 to 1.5 minutes of a song in the style of the music from Shrek (YouTube accessible) Can be show tunes or other popular or sacred music as appropriate-Show your range, ability to act through the song, and perform to the best of your ability. Provide your own accompaniment on your phone or other device. (Little ones may sing something simple without accompaniment, if necessary.)
- 2) High School Acting- Choose from among the scenes from Shrek available at the theatre classrooms to prepare and perform OR do a "cold reading" of a scene provided with other people at auditions
- 3) Junior High Acting- Same as high school
- 4) Elementary/Intermediate Acting- "Cold reading" scenes at auditions
- 5) Some limited and simple movement/dance choreographed, taught, and performed in groups at after-school auditions, if time allows

**All elementary, intermediate, and junior high students
3rd through 8th grade are encouraged to audition,
in addition to all high school kids, whether in theatre classes or not.**

Tuesday, September 19th- High School auditions by appointment during the school day and after school until we're done with all auditions that day (Acting and singing, and some limited movement for all on stage)
Crew/Technicians- Interview/interest survey by appointment or after school until we're done

Wednesday, September 20th- High School auditions by appointment during the school day and after school (on-stage and crew/technicians.) Junior high, intermediate, and elementary auditions after school (Acting and singing, and some limited movement for all)

Thursday, September 21st- High School call-backs by appointment and/or after school (on-stage and crew)
Make-up auditions for high schoolers, junior high, intermediate, and elementary auditions for those who were unable to audition before (Acting and singing, and some limited movement)
